I. Title of the paper

II. Review content (the length of the review depends on the reviewer but the review should contain answers to the following questions):

1. Is the problem presented in the paper scientifically relevant?
2. Does the paper contribute to the current academic research? Is it original research?
3. Is the paper's aim clearly set and realized?
4. Is the paper's subject well-presented and comprehensible?
5. Is the paper's structure logical?
6. Does the author know and utilize relevant literature?
7. Is the language and the style of the paper correct?

If the review suggests changes, we ask to clearly point them out.
